Scratch Cooking for the Future

A paid pre-apprenticeship program to explore a career in healthy school food

What

Are you interested in exploring a career in healthy school food? The Healthy School Food Pathway program gives community college students an exciting opportunity to receive education and hands-on experience in operating healthy K-12 school meal programs! Careers in school meal programs offer mission-driven work that is during the day Monday thru Friday with additional benefits. By participating in this pre-apprenticeship program, students can build their professional knowledge around nutrition and the culinary arts.

The program lasts 7 weeks and includes:

- 4 <u>School Food Institute</u> courses: 20 hours (4 hours pre-read, 4 hours homework, 12 hours online learning)
- 2 virtual learning sessions: 3 hours (2 sessions, 1.5 hours each)
- On-the-job learning: 84 hours (12 hours a week)

Pre-Apprentices will be paid \$15/hr for on the job learning*. Additionally, college credits may be available.**

- Application deadline: September 9, 2022
- Program start date: October 17, 2022
