#### Agenda and Discussion Summary

#### 1. Welcome and Introductions

- 4. Updates: Basic Police Academy



- BPA 216 Graduation scheduled in two and a half weeks; 38 graduates from 13 agencies.
- April 217 Academy has 30 students; July 218 Academy will start July 21 with ~45 recruits.
- Active shooter training (LD43) will be added in April 2026, extending the academy from 20 to 21 weeks.
- Mandatory pre-class orientation was successfully implemented; will become a separate 8-hour course by January 2026.

## 5. Radio Communication Training Issues

- Concerns raised about graduates struggling with radio use during the FTO program after graduation.
- Discussion on adding more radio training and integrating it into scenario practice and training during BPA.
- Plan to explore using alternate radio channels in an effort to use the radio during testing, along with scheduling some "working lunches" during week 18-20 for additional radio work with the RTOs.

## 6. Graduation Ceremony Adjustments

- A general conversation was brought up by some of the members about the length of our graduation ceremonies. Collectively, everyone agreed we could work to short the graduation ceremony – one hour range is ideal and always the target.
  - 1. Awards may be presented prior to the ceremony, with only key awards announced publicly.
  - 2. Plan to include an awards page in the printed program so that our individual award winners are publicly recognized in this manner.
